NDHU Guidelines for Information Appliance Fee

- 1. The following guidelines (hereinafter referred to as the Guidelines) are established in accordance with the Tai (87) Dian-Tzu-87019503 of the MOE, and the user-reimbursement guidelines.
- 2. The information appliance fee collected are to be use on management and maintenance of computers and network.
- 3. Information Appliance Fee and Services:
 - (1)NDHU provides students with individual email accounts, a variety of Internet services including WWW, BBS, NEWS, and related facilities including Computer Classrooms.
 - (2)NT\$300 is to be collected when registering at the beginning of each semester to cover the internet communication fee of that semester.
- 4. The following students are eligible for a refund when the refund list is confirmed in March and October every year:
 - (1) Those who study in other countries under the international exchange program.
 - (2) Those who are dual enrolled at NDHU and charged the fee twice with registration.
- 5. Except (for) those who are described in Guideline No.4, there is no refund for the information appliance fee.
- 6. These rules and all amendments are implemented upon ratification by the Administrative Council and approval by the President.
